

**APPLICATION FOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP
OKLAHOMA ONE-CALL SYSTEM, INC.**

WHEREAS, Oklahoma One-Call System, Inc. (the "Corporation"), an Oklahoma non-profit corporation, has been formed in an effort to reduce damage to the underground facilities of its members and to cause to be established a statewide notification center (the "Notification Center");

WHEREAS, the undersigned represents that it has underground facilities located within the state of Oklahoma and is otherwise eligible to be a Associate Member of the Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned desires to be a Associate Member of the Corporation and hereby tenders with this application the applicable fee as specified by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned hereby applies for admission as a Associate Member of the Corporation and in connection therewith covenants and agrees when accepted as a General Member as follows:

1. To abide by and comply with the requirements of the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act, 63 O.S. 1981, 142.1 et. seq. (the "Damage Prevention Act");
2. To abide by and comply with such rules and regulations as the Board of Directors may adopt, from time to time, for utilization of the statewide notification center by members;
3. To abide by and comply with the bylaws of the Corporation except that if Section 3, Article III, of said bylaws as adopted on December 18, 1979, shall be amended, the undersigned shall, nevertheless, be privileged to terminate its membership pursuant to said Section 3 as though the same had not been amended;
4. To pay promptly the annual fees prescribed by the Board of Directors of the Corporation;
5. That the Corporation shall not be liable to any member, regardless of whether that member is a general, associate or sustaining member, for any injury, loss, liability, demand, claim, damage, cost or expense, including court costs and attorney's fees, whether physical or economic, incurred by any member as a result, in whole or in part, of any action or failure to act, whether negligent, grossly negligent or otherwise, by the Corporation, or its officers, directors, employees, agents or contractors, in carrying out any of the provisions or requirements of the Damage Prevention Act or in providing any services required by the terms of this Membership Agreement; and
6. Not to sue the Corporation, its officers, directors, employees, agents, or contractors, under any circumstances or upon any grounds for any injury, loss, liability, demand, claim, damage, cost or expense, including court costs and attorney's fees, whether physical or economic, incurred by any member as a result, in whole or in part, of any action or failure to act, whether solely negligent, grossly negligent or otherwise, by the Corporation, or its officers, directors, employees, agents or contractors, in carrying out any of the provisions or requirements of the Damage Prevention Act, or in providing any services required by the terms of this Membership Agreement.
